## WHAT RESIDENTS ARE SAYING

"I've walked every soi in Ari. The thing people don't realise until they're here: the weekend market on Soi Ari 1 is the best morning ritual in Bangkok. Fresh fruit, coffee, and you're seeing actual local life — not the expat bubble version of it. That alone is worth the slightly higher rent."

## SEASONAL GUIDE

### RAINY (MAY-OCT)

Minor flooding on Soi Ari 1 during heavy rain. Higher floors unaffected. Street food stalls move indoors.

### HOT (MAR-MAY)

AC runs all day — budget 2800-1,200 extra on electricity. Morning walks pleasant before 8am. Afternoons indoors.

### COOL (NOV-FEB)

Best season. Morning walks comfortable all day. Ari's outdoor cafes are at their best Nov-Feb.

## WHAT NOBODY TELLS YOU

Soi Ari 1 runs a Friday-Saturday night market 6-10pm. Units on this soi get 3-4 hours of bass and crowd noise weekly.

Sarnies cafe on Soi Ari 4 is the most reliable work cafe in the area — fiber, consistent 80+ Mbps, rarely overcrowded before 10am.

BTS Ari is 10 minutes walk from most of the sois people actually live in — not 5 minutes as listings claim.

## BEFORE YOU NEGOTIATE

**Standard deposit** 2 months rent paid at signing. Some smaller buildings accept 1.5 months for tenants with stable income proof.

**Minimum lease** 1 year standard. 6-month leases exist in serviced apartments — expect 10-15% premium on monthly rate.

<b>Electricity billing</b>	Government rate (₹3.80-4.50/unit) is standard in most Ari buildings. Verify in writing before signing.
<b>What to ask for</b>	Deposit reduction to 1.5 months if paying 3+ months upfront. Free first month if unit has been vacant over 60 days. Ask for lease break clause after month 6.
<b>Red flag terms</b>	Deposit over 2 months without justification. Electricity rate above ₹6/unit. No TM30 clause in lease. "No pets" clause with unclear definition covering service animals.

Timing: Plan 5-7 days in Ari before committing — good units at fair prices get taken within 3-4 days of listing. Rush decisions in Ari almost always mean paying above market.
